5. Desposal of Trophies, 1942 4 boxes 1 ft. 4 in.  
Files alphabetical by towns. Field guns and machine guns were disposed of in virtue of order-in-council P.C. 2516 by Chairman of Military Museum (Dominion Archivist) and Salvage Office of Treasury Board.

- (5) Demands for War Trophies from individuals and towns. Lists.
- (6) Demands for War Trophies by Battalions who captured them. Listed by Battalions. 1 set for heavy guns, 1 set for machine guns.
- (7) Demands for War Trophies, with allotment.  
Indicates name of town, type of trophy required etc.
- (8) Suggestions for the distribution of captured stores.  
Memo by A.G. Doughty with tables. In appendix, official correspondence re ownership, and distribution; also list of persons to be advised of shipping of guns.
- (9) Report of the Award of War Trophies, claims and allotments.  
Report of Commission on War Records and Trophies, upon the proper policy to be adopted for the distribution of such trophies, dated Jan. 18, 1920. Followed by list, by province of towns claiming trophies, with trophies allotted, and date of delivery added in ink. Also list of number and calibre of guns allotted to Provinces.
- (10) Report of the Award of Machine Guns, claims and allotments.  
Lists same as in (9) above.
- (11) Lists of War battles, military districts, overseas units.
- (12) Incomplete index catalogue.
- (13) Various lists, unsorted.
- (14) Pamphlet on Canadian War Trophies and photographs, or British museums.
