Thus individual certificates can be directly located only (a) if a date of departure or certificate number is known, (b) by using the nominal lists of readmissions and cancellations, organized by date, or (c) by reading through all certificates in the date range desired. As Access restrictions apply to these records, consult the archivist for advice in the use of this series.

There are annotations in some of the earliest volumes of the Chinese General Registers (RG 76 vols. 694-703) indicating issuance of "certificates of leave" to individuals, but these do not continue past about 1900.
