## COOPERATIVE PROJECT

### Library Support to Makerere University, Uganda

The International Development Office of the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada is initiating a pilot project to assist the Library of Makerere University in Kampala, Uganda, in its recovery from eight years of financial stringency and political upheaval. Funding from the Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) and the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) has made it possible to hire a full-time librarian. The National Librarian is providing an office and other indispensable accommodations in the National Library of Canada. The project functions through a ten-member group (Makerere University Library Support Committee) centered in Ottawa and work is already well under way in several crucial activities.

Head librarians and interested professors on various university campuses throughout Canada have been contacted with a view to establishing committees on a local basis that would cooperate in the collection of relevant books and journals from library discards and duplicates, and items from professors' private collections. Following collection week, scheduled to begin on March 15, 1981, relevant items will be transferred to the nearest one of ten Overseas Book Centres in Canada. Assistance in this selection process will be made possible by a subject analysis now being conducted by the Committee's Librarian, based upon lists of needed books and periodicals received to date from the Makerere University Library. Subject lists will be provided for local university campus committees,

depending upon their specific areas of collection concentration. The visit of James Mugasha, Makerere University's Librarian, to Canada in early April is currently being planned. Mr. Mugasha will survey items that have been transferred to Overseas Book Centres and organized by their staff prior to final shipment to Uganda.

In design, this pilot project will have a four-month lifespan. If successful, it may be continued in order to aid other struggling Third World university libraries. Groups or individuals interested in providing assistance to this project and those which may develop in the future are invited to contact the Committee Chairman, Dr. D.G. Anglin, of the Political Science Department of Carleton University, or the office of the Committee's Librarian, Patricia McKenna, in the following location:
