## **Alan Mills Collection - 1978-16**

3 1/4" audio tapes, 1 acetate disc.

Dubbed from originals owned by Mills, these tapes contain a variety of concert and broadcast appearances. Included are "Time for Alan Mills", "Song Swap" with Sam Hinton and Tom Kines, "Canadiana" a series of thirteen programmes each giving the history of a Canadian folk song, a concert at Michigan State University (15 July 1964), children's programmes, "Songs for Canada's Birthday" with Joyce Sullivan, Jean Price, Jacques Labreque, Tom Kines, H  l  ne Baillargeon, and Charles Jordan, and the radio plays "Ti-Jean and the Devil" and "Klondike Mike". Altogether 280 songs are performed on these tapes. A list is available of these songs. Acetate disc is of Mills performing "Mockingbird" and "Sweet Tibby Dunbar".

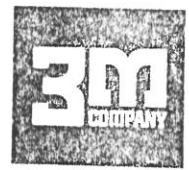

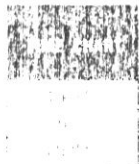


