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#### **INTRODUCTION**

#### Presentation of the Fonds

When the Espace Musique fonds was acquired by the Music Division of the National Library of Canada in 1990, it consisted of 2 linear meters of documents encompassing the years 1978 to 1991. These archives give evidence of the activities of the society.

At the time of their acquisition, the documents of the fonds were not organized in any particular manner on which the classification scheme could be based. As a result, the seven series were based, for the most part, upon the principal activities of the society.

The first series contains documents relating to the foundation of the concert society. The following two series entitled **ADMINISTRATION** and **FINANCES**, comprise certain documents which have been placed under restriction for a period of ten years. However, the researcher may consult the President's and the Music Director's reports. The series D consists of general correspondence and form letters which are mostly sent by Espace Musique to promote future concerts. The series **CONCERTS AND ARTISTS FILES** contains the largest portion of documents within the fonds. The documents pertain to concert production, artists, concerts programmes and tickets, publicity and surveys. The final two series are those of **CLIPPINGS** and the **MISCELLANEOUS DOCUMENTS**.


#### Classification, Selection and Description.

Different methods of classification have been used in the development of the series and sub-series. For example, the series **ADMINISTRATION** (B) is based upon the duties and activities of the society. The series **CLIPPINGS** (F) illustrates a classification by the type of document. Items within certain sub-series such as the **GENERAL CORRESPONDENCE** and the **PROGRAMMES** follow a chronological order.

A total of 1.18 m. of documents were eliminated from the fonds (42cm of duplicates and 40 cm of receipts, cheques, stubs and account statements.) In addition, a total of 36 cm. of concert programmes and posters, as well as pamphlets and brochures, which were not related in any way to Espace Musique were transferred to the Music Division's Printed Collection. This brings the Espace Musique fonds to a final measurement of 82 cm.

Describing the fonds at the level of the article, this finding aid is of the numerical list type.

A file code facilitates the retrieval of the articles. It is presented as follows.



Lastly, a name index and a file code index complete the finding aid.

There are restrictions which apply to the consultation of certain documents within the Espace Musique fonds. The financial documents and the minutes of the board meeting are under restriction for a period of ten years, from the date of the document.

### ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY

The Espace Musique Concert Society of Ottawa was founded in 1979 by Gerald Corey with the help of Jane Forner, Gary Hayes, Trudi Le Caine, Keith MacMillan, Robert Richard and Jean-Jacques Van Vlasselaer. One year later, the society was incorporated with the following objectives: to promote interest in the art of music and contemporary musical ideas and; to advance knowledge and appreciation of musical culture with special emphasis on contemporary music.

This new concert society offers composers the possibility of having their works performed. Espace Musique organizes informal workshops and demonstrations, presents multi-media concerts and commissions new works. In its infancy, the society presented music from all periods, including rarely heard works. By 1985, their concerts were almost exclusively of contemporary music.

Espace Musique's first concert was presented on May 24, 1979 at the Château Laurier. *Offrande III* by Serge Garant was performed under the direction of the composer. Since then, the concert society has been the host of numerous musical ensemble such as the Canadian Electronic Ensemble, l'Ensemble Daedaleus, Arraymusic, the Schoenberg Ensemble and the British Ensemble Lontano. With the collaboration of the embassies in Ottawa, the society has been able to present works of composers including Luciano Berio, Leo Brouwer, and Krzysztof Penderecki.

The society's visiting artistes are often recognized not only nationally but internationally. It also has its own resident ensemble, the Pierrot Ensemble, which was formed in 1987 and composed largely of musicians from the National Arts Center Orchestra.

Espace Musique is a non-profit organization, relying on donations, grants or otherwise to function. It's members are all volunteers with the exception of the Pierrot Ensemble and secretarial staff. Artistic directors of the society have been Gerald Corey (1979 – 85), Christina Petrowska (1985 – 88), and Robert Cram (1988 – 91.) Presidents have been Trudi LeCaine (1980 – 81), Keith MacMillan (1981 – 83) David Piper (1983 – 84), Guy Huot (1984 – 87), Patrick Cardy (1987 – 88), and Florence Hayes (1988-89) succeeded by Louis Majeau.
