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INTRODUCTION

The arrangement of the Speeches reflects the way the papers came to the Public Archives in several series of overlapping files. The Bound Volumes contain mainly typewritten speech notes and speech material. The Chronological Files consist mainly of clippings reporting on speeches, as well as some typewritten material. The St. Laurent Files (so-called because they were received from the Prime Minister's Office when Louis St. Laurent was in office) contain both clippings and typewritten material.
