#### HISTORICAL NOTE

After the Bolshevik occupation of Ukraine, the Ukrainian National Government in Exile (UNGE) was established in Poland in 1920. UNGE had representatives in most of the larger Ukrainian communities outside of Ukraine including Canada. The work of the UNGE consisted of submitting numerous protests against the occupation of Ukraine particularly before the League of Nations and in disseminating information promoting the cause of Ukrainian independence.

With the outbreak of the Second World War in 1939, the functions of the UNGE were transferred from Warsaw, Poland to Paris, France. However, UNGE was obliged to cease all activities in 1940 with the occupation of France by Nazi Germany. Their archives both in Warsaw and in Paris were subsequently lost.

In 1947, the Ukrainian National Council was organized as an attempt to continue the ideological and legal tradition of the UNGE. The headquarters for many years were in Munich, Germany. They renewed contacts with the old communities and established links with the new Ukrainian immigrants throughout the world. They also continued the work from the pre-World War II period by submitting petitions and letters to the United Nations and producing information promoting the cause of Ukrainian independence. A main area of financial and political support was the large Ukrainian community in Canada. Various local auxiliary organizations were created to provide financial and material support to UNGE.

On 20 August, 1980 an agreement was signed between the Committee to Commemorate the Sixtieth Jubilee of the Ukrainian National Government in Exile through Archives (the Committee) and the National Archives of Canada to preserve the records of the UNGE. The Committee was composed of Canadian citizens of Ukrainian descent from the Ottawa area. The purpose of this agreement was to provide a 'home' to the UNGE Collection and since Canada had a large Ukrainian community, the National Archives of Canada was considered to be an appropriate repository. Article 2 of the Agreement reads:

'The materials shall be the property of the Crown, provided that at some future date they could be transferred to the Archives of Ukraine, if in the opinion of the Dominion Archivist and UNGE (or its successors) a truly independent government exists in Ukraine. Any such transfer shall be discussed and agreed upon directly by the Dominion Archivist and the Chief Archivist of Independent Ukraine'.

In 1983, the UNGE headquarters were transferred from Munich, Germany to Philadelphia, USA. At that time, a large number of records were transferred to the National Archives of Canada. Also, a number of donations were received from individuals in Canada and the United States. It should also be mentioned that UNGE-related material is found in other Ukrainian archival fonds at the

National Archives.

On 23 August, 1992, the UNGE officially transferred power to the Ukrainian government in Kiev, Ukraine.

On 28 January, 1994 on the occasion of a visit of a delegation from the Main Archival Administration under the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine to the National Archives of Canada, the Committee formally agreed that the UNGE fonds may be transferred to Ukraine.

The Canadian-related section of the UNGE Collection was organized and microfilmed in order to retain historical information concerning the activities of the UNGE auxiliary in Canada.
