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Introduction to AYA Press

A member of the Literary Press Group of the Association of Canadian Publishers, Aya Press has published 21 titles in 7 years, 1977-1984. Although this Toronto-based publishing house is one of the smallest of Canada's small literary presses, Aya Press is renowned for both the outstanding quality and the eclectic nature of its publications.

Glynn Davies, founded Aya Press from scratch with his own funds and launched his publishing programme in 1978 with Itzy Borenstein's Ancient Music. Shortly after, Davies acquired and distributed the stock of Basilike Press, his brother Paul's small but short-lived literary press. Glynn Davies' interest in contemporary Canadian poetry continued; Aya Press has published the works of experimental poets such as bp Nichol and Steve McCaffery and of lesser-known Canadian poets. Interest in contemporary Canadian poetry culminated in the Aya Press Poetry Series which has grown to six titles to date. Aya Press has also undertaken a number of volumes of fiction by such writers as Leon Rooke, Rikki, Susan Kerslake and Sharon Drache. Perhaps the most commercially successful books have been the three short-fiction anthologies edited by Geoff Hancock of Canadian Fiction Magazine: Magic Realism and the two-volume set Illusion: Fantasy, Fables, Metafiction.

Aya Press has been fortunate in its collaboration with designer Paul Davies and with Tim Inkster of Porcupine's Quill, a printer distinguished by his pleasing designs and meticulous care in their execution. Jane and Tony Urquart's I am Walking in the Garden of His Imaginary Palace is not the only Aya Press publication to receive recognition for its excellent design. While most books are published in limited editions of five hundred or fewer copies, many are also released in deluxe editions. Among book collectors, as among aficionados of contemporary Canadian literature, Aya Press has found a definite niche.

It is significant that Aya Press contended with and survived a harsh period in the history of Canadian publishing. Aya's success can be attributed to the acumen of its publisher-editor, Glynn Davies. In order to ensure survival, few publishing projects were undertaken without a guarantee of external financial support, usually through the federal or provincial governments. Aya Press was also careful with its sales and distribution. Most books were sold directly through the mail while the rest were sold through the Literary Press Group Catalogue or through selected specialty book stores such as This Aint the Rosedale Library. Since 1977, Aya Press has grown to a comfortable size; averaging four titles a year, Aya is a small but vital literary press.

Scope and Contents

The Aya Press collection covers virtually every publishing project undertaken since 1978, a total of 21 titles. The collection is of particular interest to anyone examining small press publishing in Canada. As well as correspondence about solicited and unsolicited manuscripts, these papers thoroughly record the process of publication for each title. Those interested in book design will also be rewarded; correspondence between Porcupine's Quill and Glynn Davies as well as much of the artwork used to illustrate Aya Press publications is included. The financial records of Aya Press have been meticulously kept, providing an exact record of the business of small press publishing in Canada.

In sum, the papers of Aya Press document one of Canada's important small literary presses through a volatile and exciting period in the history of Canadan publishing and letters.
