MG 27 III C 28 HAYDON, Andrew (1867-1932). Senator.

Originals, 1798-1931, 1957-1964. 1.5 m. Finding Aid No. 1673.

Andrew Haydon was born in Pakenham, Ontario. After graduating from Queen's University in Kingston and Osgoode Hall in Toronto, Haydon practised law in Lanark, Ontario, 1897 to 1899, and later in Ottawa. He was Secretary of the National Liberal Convention of 1919, and from 1920 unitl 1922 he was General Secretary of the National Liberal Organization Committee. In 1924 Haydon was called to the Senate. He was the author of Pioneer Sketches in the District of Bathurst and Mackenzie King and the Liberal Party.

Presented in 1904 by Andrew Haydon and in 1980 by Mr. H.E. Kidd; Mrs Olive Walker presented the scrapbooks in 1986. Publications were transferred to the Archives Library.

Finding Aid No. 1673 is a descriptive file list.

Correspondence, 1919-1931. 5 cm (volume 1).

Correspondence with and from William Lyon Mackenzie King, September 1919 to January 1931 regarding the organization and activities of the National Liberal Committee. This correspondence was kept by Andrew Haydon, General Secretary of the National Liberal Committee. Other issues covered include the federal election campaigns during the twenties and in particular the demise of Unionist support, 1920-1921.

Newspaper Clippings, 1925. 1 cm (volume 1). These clippings cover electoral issues in 1925.

Lanark County Manuscript, 1893. 4 cm (volume 1).

An account of the development of Lanark County indicating its geographical extent, settlement, economic resources and municipal organization written by Andrew Haydon in 1893.

Scrapbooks, Indexes, District of Bathurst, 1798-1926, 1957-1964. 1.4 m (volumes 2-8).

Scrapbooks created by Andrew Haydon comprising clippings, notes, posters and related correspondence and memoranda concerning the history of Lanark, Renfrew and Carleton counties. The scrapbooks were used to write Pioneer Sketches in the District of Bathurst (volume 1) 1925. No volumes after volume one were ever published but much additional data for future volumes are found in the scrapbooks.

The scrapbooks were used as sources by Harry and Olive Walker in writing the <u>Carleton Saga</u>. 1968. They and their researchers completed extensive indexes which greatly increase the research value of the scrapboks. Indexes to certain historical works lacking indexes such as J.L.
