The journal covers his arrival at York Factory (Manitoba), work at the Red River Settlement (Manitoba), journey to the United States to buy sheep, and his assignment to the Mackenzie River district. Locations and events include Fort de Liard (Northwest Territories), Fort Halkett (British Columbia), Lake Frances (Yukon), Pelly Banks (Yukon), and the establishment of Fort Selkirk (Yukon). Campbell records encounters with Indigenous groups including Saulteaux (Ojibwe), Cree, Métis, Dakota, Meskwaki (Fox), Kaska Dena, Northern Tutchone, and Chilkat Tlingit (Jilkáat Kwáan). His notes discuss seasonal harvesting locations, territory boundaries, cultural practices, beliefs, trade conflicts between groups, Russians and/or the Hudson's Bay Company (HBC), and historical figures Chief Wanata and Chief Shakes (likely Shakes IV). The Pelly Banks Post (also known as Fort Pelly Banks) is a Hudson's Bay Company (HBC) post located on the Pelly River at Big Campbell Creek, near Ross River. It was burned down in 1849. Topics include but are not limited to trade relationships and seasonal harvesting patterns. The journal mentions Northern Tutchone, Kaska Dena, and Teslin Tlingit.
