General Note: The St. Roch, first launched in 1928, was built to patrol the Canadian Arctic, supply RCMP detachments along the coast and in effect serve as a floating detachment. In addition to policing duties, the St. Roch assisted with other government tasks in the Arctic at a time when Ottawa was expanding its control and development of the far north. The ship visited Herschel Island, Tukoyaktuk, Coppermine (present-day Kugluktuk, Nunavut) Cambridge Bay, Baillie Island and other communities. She was used to transport the sick and injured to hospital, children to residential schools and officials for court sessions, collect customs duties and taxes, deliver mail and government payments, handle hunting licences and maintain vital statistics. During the winter while frozen in ice the ship served as a base camp for officers to conduct patrols, bringing with them a system of justice and 'goodwill' to the native population.
