							These newspaper clippings are related to either Dr. Hemmerich himself or to the ship Nascopie. Many articles related to the running aground of the Nascopie in 1947 are included. Newspaper clippings from the 1950-1955 period, with some undated. Mainly general articles about the Canadian North, its resources, the life of its inhabitants, etc. Of note is an article from the Kitchener-Waterloo Record (May 14, 1955) about Dr. Hemmerich and his trips to the North. This file contains letters written or received by Dr. Roy G. Hemmerich between 1939 and 1945 (most letters are from 1944-45). Of note is a letter from the Hudson Bay Company, dated April 16th, 1945, informing Dr. Hemmerich of the comapny's expectations with regards to the 1945 Eastern Arctic voyage of the Nascopie. The file also contains letters from Dr. Hemmerich to his family written during the 1945 voyage.
